3. Classes meeting four or five days a week at the same time, and classes meeting for more than one time period will hold exams according to the time and day of the first scheduled class meeting of the week. Example: a class meeting Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday at 8:00 a.m., will hold its examination at the time scheduled 8:00 a.m., MWF.
