FINAL EXAM POLICY

- 1.** All students enrolled in a course requiring a final examination, graduating seniors and graduate students included, are required to take the exam at the time scheduled.
- 2.** Allowing a student to take an examination or a test in lieu of a final examination at any time other than the regularly scheduled final examination is a violation of university policy.
- 3.** Classes meeting four or five days a week at the same time and classes meeting for more than one time period will hold exams according to the time and day of the first scheduled class meeting of the week. Example: A class meeting Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday at 8:00 a.m., will hold its examination at the time scheduled @ 8:00 a.m., Monday, Wednesday, Friday.
