

ETHICS IN BUSINESS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM GUIDELINES

PURPOSE:

The Ethics in Business Scholarship is a need-based scholarship to assist full-time, degree-seeking, undergraduate students attending Florida A&M University. Need will be determined from the need analysis form generated by the “Free Application for Federal Student Aid” (FAFSA) and other normal methods of scholarship determination.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Student must be currently enrolled with reasonable progress towards graduation and in good scholastic standing with the University.
- Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 and must have successfully passed the Business Ethics course (MAN3701) with a grade of “C” or better.
- Student must be a U.S. citizen.
- Student must be a Florida resident (this scholarship is open to in-state students only).
- Student must have a minimum of three (3) course credit hours in Business Ethics.
- Student must have documented 10 hours of community/volunteer services.
- Student must provide a statement of purpose/need for Scholarship.
- Prior recipients of the Business Ethics Scholarship are not eligible for subsequent awards.

AWARDS:

Awards will vary based on need. All applications will be reviewed and awarded accordingly. Recipients of the award will be duly notified. Please ensure that all address/mailing information is correct. Scholarship is contingent upon funding availability, and is awarded for one semester unless otherwise stated.

APPLICATION:

Application packets may be obtained from the Office of the Vice President for Academic Affairs, Office of the Vice President for Student Affairs, Office of the Dean of Students, and the offices of Academic Deans. Students must submit the need analysis form (Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)) through its normal procedures in order to be considered for the Business and Ethics Scholarship.

APPLICATION DEADLINES:

*December 1st (Spring Semester)
April 2nd (Summer Semester)
July 21st (Fall Semester)*
