**NOTICE OF PROPOSED NEW REGULATION**

**DATE:** May 26, 2006

**REGULATION CHAPTER TITLE:** Student Affairs

**REGULATION TITLE AND NUMBER:** Housing (2.001)

**SUMMARY OF REGULATION:** The amended Regulation deletes obsolete language; provides the criteria for eligibility to reside in University housing facilities; requires all freshmen reside in on-campus traditional dormitories unless waived by the University or the President's designee; and incorporates the terms and conditions of residence provided in certain University documents such as the Residence Life Handbook. The Regulation also grants the Vice President for Student Affairs authority to appoint a committee to review and recommend revisions to the Residence Life Handbook and the Director of Housing to institute additional guidelines governing operations of the Housing Department with the approval of the Vice President for Student Affairs provided notification is given to residents prior to implementing such guidelines.
