SUMMARY OF REPEAL: The above-referenced regulations have not been revised in many years. Consequently the regulations do not reflect changes in current governing statutes, state university system regulations, or University policies. As a result of substantial rewording of multiple sections, the regulations are proposed for repeal and will be replaced with new or amended language as set forth in proposed Purchasing Program Regulations. In addition, several sections referenced herein have been renumbered, merged and transferred to streamline this Regulation. Obsolete provisions have also been deleted.
