As we prepare for Hurricane Michael, we want to ensure your safety and well-being. While it's still early, it appears that Hurricane Michael could directly impact Tallahassee based on the most recent forecast from the National Hurricane Center. It is important that you keep a close eye on this storm.

The Office of University Housing is working diligently to prepare for the storm and you should as well. Collect and gather necessities such as water, first aid kits, medications, batteries, canned goods, and etc.

If you plan on leaving campus, you **MUST** first sign out with your hall staff. Consult with a representative at the front desk of your facility prior to leaving, for more details.

If you are choosing to stay in your facility, set up an "out-of-town" contact. This contact can be your parents, family members, or a friend whom you could call to keep updated on local changes and your condition.

It is not mandatory that you leave your residence hall. FAMU is prepared to support students throughout the storm. On-campus residence halls and dining facilities will remain open for current residential students during this closure.

Foster-Tanner will also serve as shelter, if needed. Doors will be opened at 12 P.M. tomorrow.
