

FLORIDA A&M UNIVERSITY Founded in 1887 as the State Normal College for Colored Founded in 1887 as the State Normal Confege for Content is Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University (FAMU) is historically state supported educational facility for Americans in Florida. It has always Minimially state supported educational facility for in 1890, Americans in Florida. It has always been co-educational. In 1890, the second Morrill Act was passed. This enabled the school to secone the Black Land Grant College for the State. become the Black Land Grant College for the State of Florida. In 1891, the college was moved from its original location west of fown to its present location which was once the site of "Highwood," Territorial Governor W.P. Duval's slave plantation The site is one of the highest hills in Tallahassee. The school wes known as Florida A&M College from 1909 until 1953, it attained university status. On May 6, 1996, the historic Florida A&M University camp

listed in the National Register of Historic Discovery
