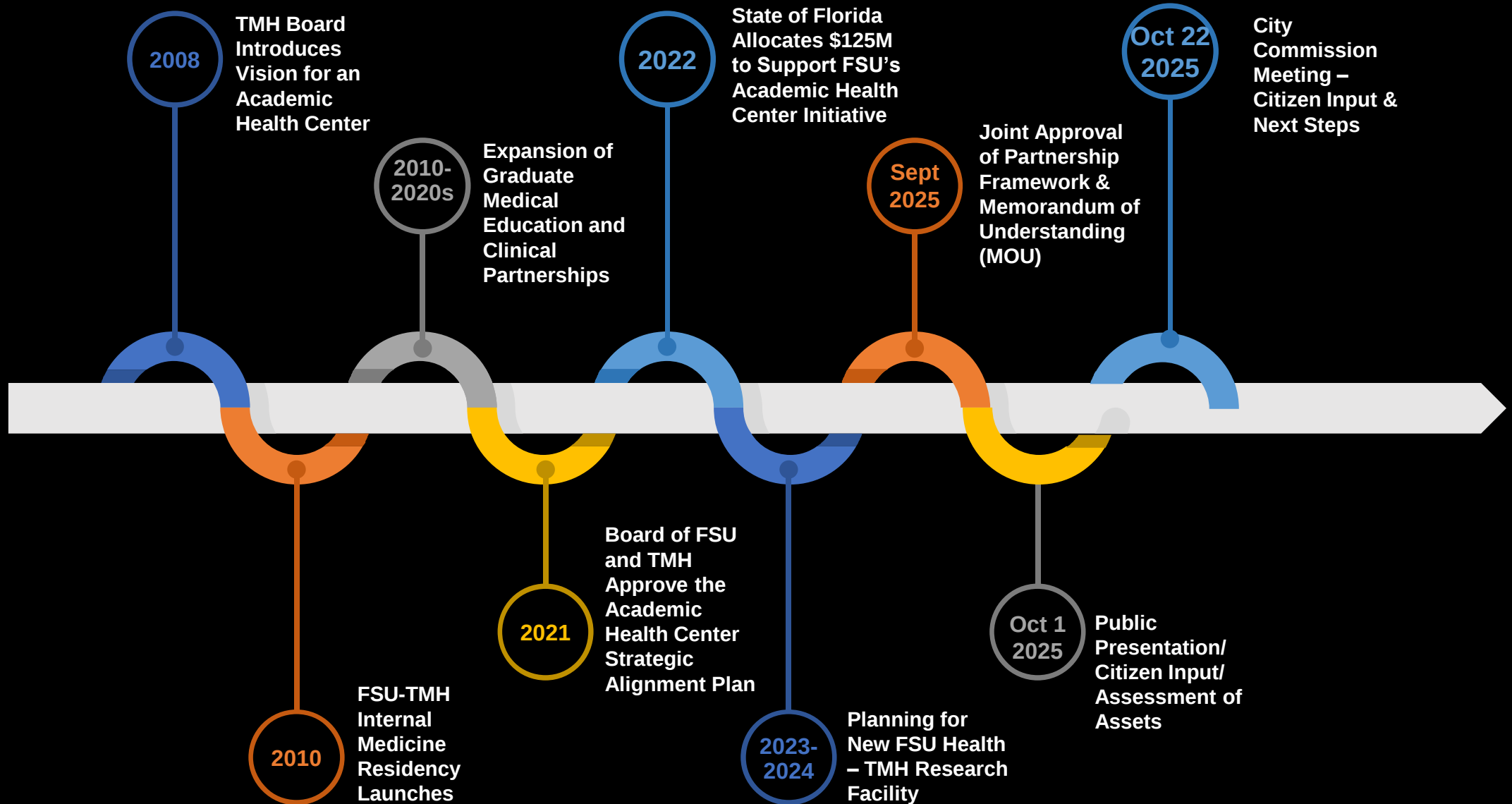

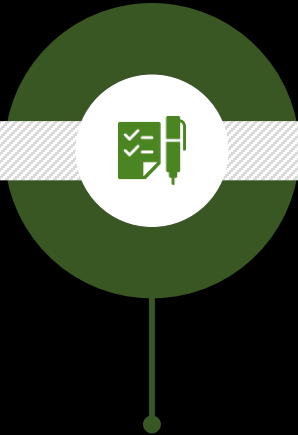

August 2025



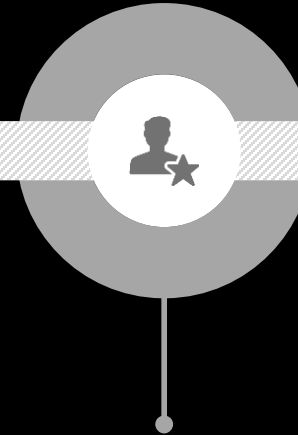
Division of HSERI

Safeguard the growth of FAMU's distinct health science programs

Safeguard duplication of existing FAMU Health Sciences Programs

Safeguard FAMU's ability to establish new non-duplicative Health Science Programs

Exempt FAMU from exclusivity clauses that restrict partnerships

Include a Five-Year Review Clause

Report annually on FAMU's metrics related to student outcomes

Establish clear protections to maintain FAMU's training and research access
