Subject: Report and Recommendations from the Special Committee on the College of Law

Background Information and Summary: The Special Committee on the College of Law was established in April 2025 in response to the Gunster Assessment Report prepared by Simone Marstiller. The report highlighted critical institutional challenges affecting the FAMU College of Law, including bar passage rates, faculty performance, strategic alignment, and student readiness.
