**REGULATION CHAPTER NO.:** Chapter 8

**REGULATION CHAPTER TITLE:** Motor Pool

**REGULATION TITLE AND NO.:** Acquisition and Disposal of Motor Vehicles - 8.003

**SUMMARY OF REGULATION:** The language in this Regulation has been incorporated in the newly amended Regulation 8.001, thereby making this section redundant and obsolete.

**AUTHORITY FOR REGULATION:** Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution, Section 1001.706, Florida Statutes, Board of Governors Regulation 1.001.

## Florida A&M University Regulation



### 8.003 Acquisition and Disposal of Motor Vehicles.

~~(1) The term “motor vehicles” includes any automobile, watercraft, aircraft, truck or other vehicles designed for transportation of persons, and construction vehicles or farm equipment.~~

~~(2) All motor vehicles shall be procured through the University’s Purchasing Department in accordance with University rules, policies and procedures.~~

~~(3) The University has the authority to:~~

~~(a) Establish standard classes of motor vehicles to be leased, purchased or used by University personnel;~~

~~(b) Establish and operate facilities for the acquisition, disposal, operation, maintenance, repair, storage, control, and regulation of University-owned motor vehicles. Acquisition may be by purchase, lease, installment purchase, loan, or by any other legal means and may include a trade-in. All motor vehicles purchased shall be of a class that will safely transport University personnel and adequately meet the requirements of the University;~~

~~(c) Obtain the most effective and efficient motor vehicles for University purposes.~~

~~(4) Disposal of surplus motor vehicles will be executed in accordance with Florida A&M University Regulation Chapter 9, Surplus Property.~~
