REGULATION CHAPTER TITLE: Administration

REGULATION TITLE AND NUMBER: Schedule of Tuition and Fees (3.017)

SUMMARY OF REGULATION: The Regulation is amended to reflect the 5% in-state undergraduate tuition increase mandated by the Florida Board of Governors, effective Spring Semester 2008.

AUTHORITY FOR REGULATION: Article IX, Florida Constitution, Board of Governors Regulation Development Procedure dated July 21, 2005.

UNIVERSITY OFFICIAL INITIATING THIS REGULATION: Mr. Roland Gaines, Vice President for Student Affairs.

FULL TEXT OF THE PROPOSED AMENDED REGULATION: The full text of the proposed amended regulation follows:

Regulations of Florida A&M University



3.017 Schedule of Tuition and Fees.

- (1) Tuition shall be defined as the basic fee charged to a student for instruction provided by the University. A charge for any other purpose shall not be included within this fee.
- (a) Resident tuition and fees, comprised of the following, shall be defined as the fees charged an enrolled student who qualifies as a Florida resident as defined in Section 1009.21, F.S., and Board of Governors Regulation 6C-7.005:
 - 1. Matriculation Fee:
 - 2. Student Financial Aid Fee;
 - 3. Capital Improvement Trust Fund Fee;
 - 4. Building Fee;
 - 5. Health Fee;
 - 6. Transportation Access Fee;
 - 7. Athletic Fee; and
 - 8. Activity and Service Fee.
- (b) Non-Resident tuition and fees, comprised of the following, shall be defined as the fees charged an enrolled student who does not qualify as a Florida resident as defined in Section 1009.21, F.S., and Board of Governors Regulation 6C-7.005:
 - 1. Matriculation Fee;
 - 2. Non-Resident Fee;
 - 3. Student Financial Aid Fee;
 - 4. Non-Resident Student Financial Aid Fee;
 - 5. Capital Improvement Trust Fund Fee;
 - 6. Building Fee;
 - 7. Health Fee:
 - 8. Transportation Access Fee;

- 9. Athletic Fee; and
- 10. Activity and Service Fee.
- (2) Registration shall be defined as consisting of two components:
- (a) Formal selection of one or more credit courses approved and scheduled by the University; and
- (b) Tuition and fee payment, partial or otherwise, or other appropriate arrangements for tuition and fee payment (deferment or third party billing) for the courses in which the student is enrolled as of the end of the drop/add period.
- (3) Tuition and fee liability shall be defined as the liability for the payment of tuition and fees incurred at the point at which the student has completed registration, as defined above.
- (4) The following tuition and fees shall be levied and collected effective Fall Semester 2004 for each student regularly enrolled, unless provided otherwise by law or in this chapter.
 - (a) Students will be assessed the following fees per credit hour:

- (c) The health fee will be expended in accordance with FAMU Regulation 2.008, unless provided otherwise by law.
- (d) The transportation access fee will be used to cover the costs of operational expenses, personnel, general programs and other services related to providing traffic and parking services to the University community unless provided otherwise by law.
- (e) The athletic fee will be used to cover the costs of operational expenses, personnel, general programs and other services related to the University's Intercollegiate Athletics program unless provided otherwise by law.
- (f) The activity and service fee will be allocated and expended in accordance with the Florida A & M University Student Body Constitution and System of Student Body Statutes, as approved by the University Board of Trustees, unless provided otherwise by law.
- (5) Pursuant to Section 1009.285, F.S., each student enrolled in the same undergraduate course for at least the third time shall be assessed an additional \$164.54 per credit hour.
- (6) Pursuant to Section 1009.28, F.S., each student enrolled in the same college-preparatory course for at least the third time shall be assessed an additional \$200.65 per credit hour.
