JOB OUTLOOK

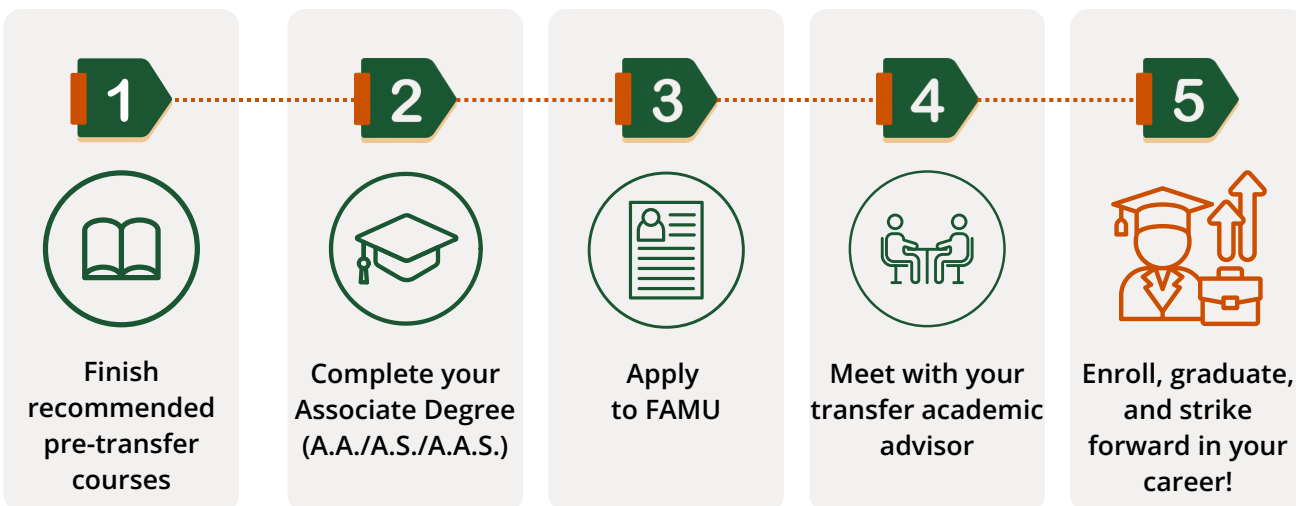
