JOB OUTLOOK

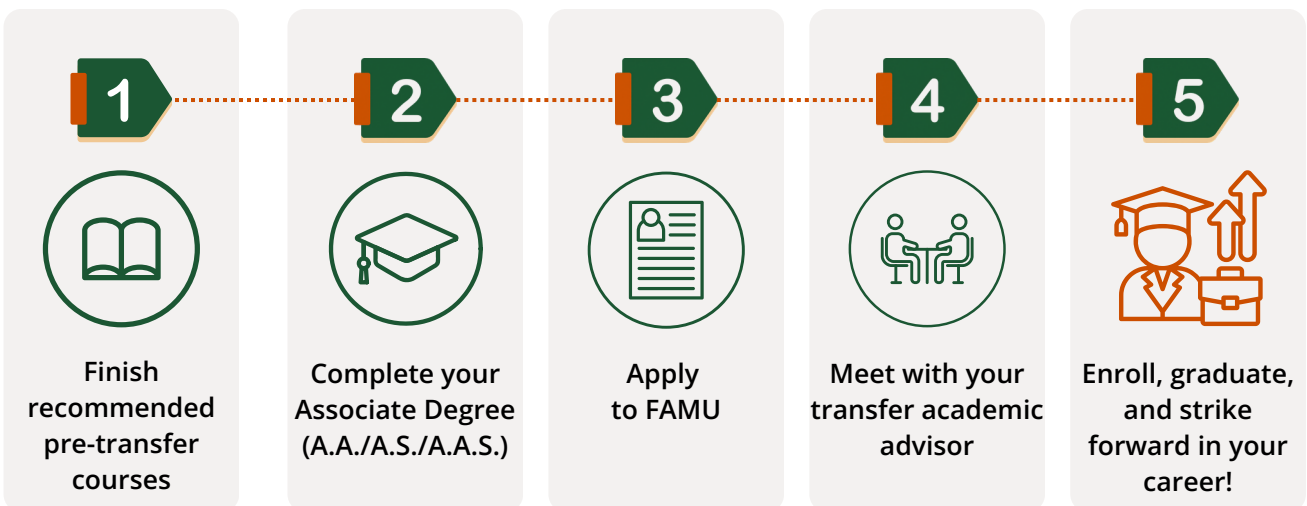
