JOB OUTLOOK

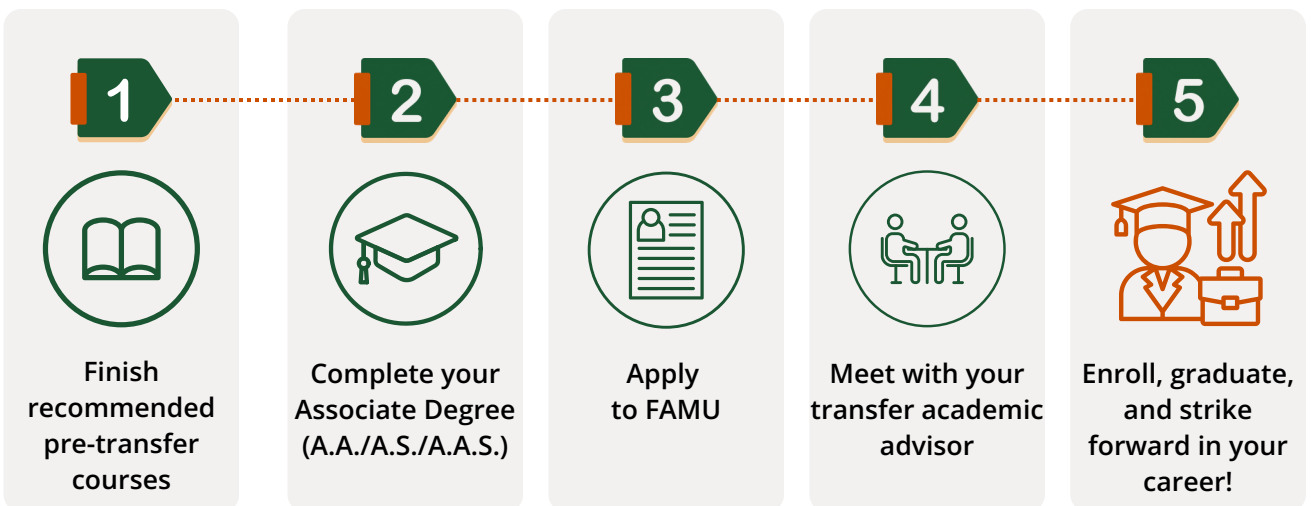
