JOB OUTLOOK

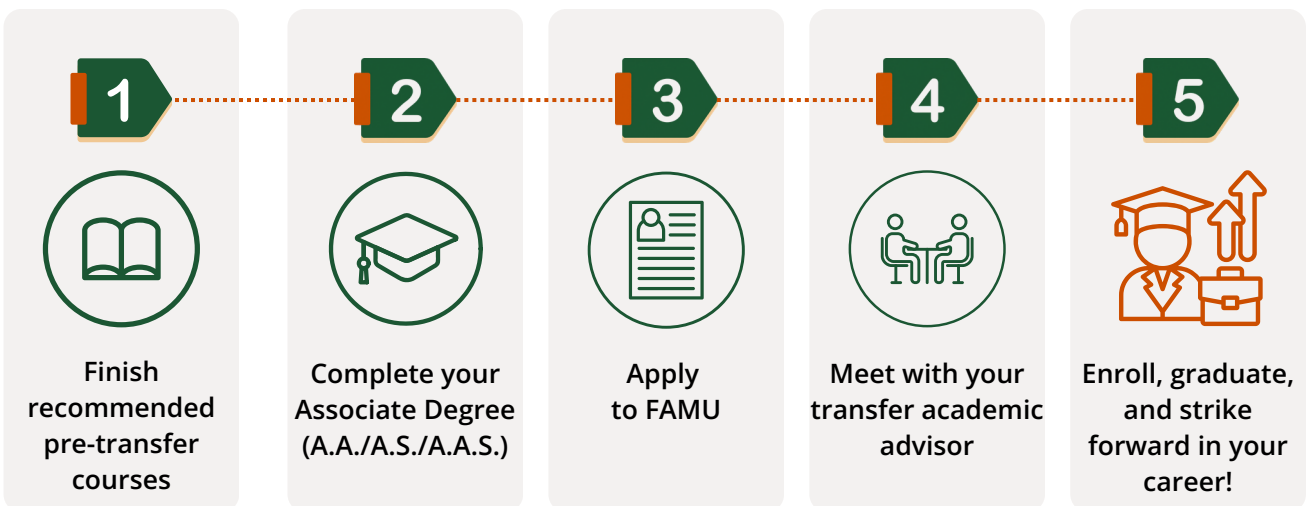
