"Great things are happening every day at Florida A&M University (FAMU)," and we must recognize the support provided by the F AMU Foundation that allows our ascension to continue. Student success, faculty excellence, and other strategic priorities are the results of executing our institutional mission and the fulfillment of our vision.

For the fourth consecutive year, FAMU is the highest-ranked public Historically Black College and University (HBCU), according to U.S News & World Report, 2022-2023 Best Colleges ranking of Top Public Universities. F AMU is also ranked 103rd among Top Public Universities. Most importantly, we are ranked 23rd among national universities in social mobility, the truest indicator of our ability to alter the economic trajectory of students, families and communities for generations to come.

Some other notable accomplishments over the past year include:

- Achieving another record-breaking year in fundraising, totaling more than \$24 million;
- Expanding to more than 50 members in the Industry Cluster;
- Setting a record for total research awards, which exceeded \$75 million;
- Receiving unprecedented support from the Florida Legislature of nearly \$70 million in new funding for infrastructure enhancements, operational support, and student success initiatives;
- Earning a \$12.59 million allocation from the Florida Board of Governors' Performance Based Funding (PBF) model;
- Completing renovation of Bragg Stadium with more than \$10 million from the City of Tallahassee/Leon County Blueprint Intergovernmental Agency; and
- Launching a new five-year strategic plan, "Boldly Striking."

None of this would be possible without the collaborative and innovative work of our exceptional faculty and staff, and the support of our alumni and friends. At FAMU, we recognize the promise in every student and understand society's need for the contributions of our graduates. Our rise in national rankings, the accolades, and the positive branding are all a testament to our focus on student success and commitment to executing our strategic plan.



# FAMU DAY OF GIVING ‘1887 STRIKES’ RAISES MORE THAN \$660,000

Florida A&M University’s Annual Day of Giving, “1887 Strikes,” campaign raised more than \$660,000 and counting. The fundraising campaign kicked off Thursday, April 21 and continued for 1,887 minutes ending Friday, April 22, at 4:27 p.m.

President Larry Robinson, Ph.D., who had urged donors to give until they went numb, was effusive in praising the successful campaign.

“We raised more than \$650,000 during our third annual “1887 Strikes” Day of Giving campaign, which is nearly \$200,000 more than last year,” Robinson said.

He thanked Frank Baker, co-founder and managing partner of Siris Capital, for his dollar-for-dollar match.

“We capitalized on his entire challenge match of \$300,000. It made a real difference,” said Robinson, who had pledged to match student donations, which increased by more than 88 percent over 2021. “You were able to raise more than \$13,902.51, which I was more than happy to match and include a donation on behalf of First Lady Sharon and me,” Robinson said in a video expressing his appreciation for the financial support and the success of the campaign.

Trustee Kimberly Moore, Ed.D., also pledged to match student donations, while FAMU Foundation Board Member Marcelia Freeman has agreed to match every new gift dollar-for-dollar made during the Day of Giving, up to \$100,000.

This was the third year since the annual Day of Giving was launched to encourage new donors to support students through FAMU Cares, FAMU National Alumni Association’s Save Our Students scholarships, colleges and schools, FAMU Athletics, and other student success initiatives. So far, “1887 Strikes” has yielded more than \$1.3 million.

Shawnta Friday-Stroud, Ph.D., vice president for University Advancement and executive director of the FAMU Foundation, was delighted with this year’s results.

“The Day of Giving was an awesome showing of support for our students,” Friday-Stroud said. “So many people gave so much during this time of need for our students; it’s just truly remarkable. We cannot thank our supporters enough for what they have done and continue to do. Without you, we would not be FAMU, and our students would not have the awesome opportunities they have to succeed.”

# FAMU RECEIVES \$1.2 MILLION GIFT FROM FRANK AND LAURA BAKER

For Frank Baker, the donation is an investment in the future.

Florida A&M University (FAMU) is excited to announce a \$1.2 million donation from Frank and Laura Baker to help students with financial challenges graduate in four years. The gift will establish the Frank and Laura Baker Graduation Fund, which will provide funding for students who are qualified to graduate in four years but have an outstanding account balance to the University.

Frank Baker is a co-founder and managing partner of Siris, a leading private equity firm with more than \$7 billion in assets under management focused on making value-oriented, control investments in technology companies. Baker said the donation to Florida's largest, and only public; Historically Black College and University (HBCU) is an investment in the future.

"In 2020, we opened a Siris office in Florida, and as part of that, we believed it was important to invest in our new community. Through our conversations with FAMU, we learned there are extremely capable students who aren't able to graduate in four years solely due to limited financial resources," Baker said. "We also discovered that the four-year graduation rate is a key metric in determining the amount of funding FAMU receives from the State of Florida. This made our 'investment' decision pretty easy — FAMU students in the work force sooner and potentially unlocking more state funding."

As part of the gift agreement, the FAMU Division of University Advancement, the Office of Student Success and Strategic Initiatives, along with Frank and Laura Baker, will review the cohort each year to determine how the Graduation Fund will be distributed. The initial \$300,000 will be used to clear University balances for spring and summer 2022 graduates once the certification process is complete and to match donations during the Day of Giving "1887 Strikes" campaign April 21-22, which raised an additional \$360,000.

"This is a transformational gift that will encourage our students to finish in a timely manner and allow them to move forward less burdened by debt to the University," said President Larry Robinson, Ph.D. "We thank Frank and Laura Baker for investing in our students. Their generosity will reap untold dividends for years to come."

The agreement also puts in place a framework for the University to track recipients; they will be asked to respond to periodic surveys in the years ahead and encouraged to give back to the University.

"The timing and magnitude of this gift cannot be overstated," said Shawnta Friday-Stroud, Ph.D., vice president for University Advancement and executive director of the FAMU Foundation. "It reinforces the importance of the task ahead and is a reminder that student success is at the core of our mission."

# KNIGHT FOUNDATION'S \$1.5M GRANT HELPS TRANSFORM NEW FAMU PERFORMING ARTS AMPHITHEATER INTO 21ST CENTURY TECH-FORWARD STUDENT HUB

**Knight Foundation's \$1.5M Grant Helps Transform New FAMU Performing Arts Amphitheater Into 21st Century Tech-Forward Student Hub**

The Will Packer Performing Arts Amphitheater will be part of the newly named Knight Foundation Plaza on FAMU's Tallahassee campus. Knight's latest FAMU investment continues its ongoing support of Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) and equitable public spaces. Florida A&M University (FAMU) announced during its Homecoming celebration that it received \$1.5 million from the Knight Foundation to add multimedia functionality to the University's new amphitheater. This new public space, which includes the Will Packer Performing Arts Amphitheater, will be known as the John S. and James L. Knight Foundation Plaza.

The investment demonstrates Knight's continued commitment to FAMU and Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) across the nation and highlights Knight's work supporting the use of technology to reshape how people experience public spaces to support equitable and inclusive public spaces that bring people together.

Knight's grant will enable students, the FAMU community and Tallahassee residents to experience visual and performing arts, news, and other programming, both in-person and virtually, at the Will Packer Performing Arts Amphitheater on FAMU's campus.

"FAMU is one of the nation's most prominent HBCUs. We're delighted to recognize and support their use of technology to promote student engagement," said Knight Foundation President Alberto Ibargüen. "Creating an environment to better inform and engage communities is essential to strengthen democracy, which is at the core of Knight's values. FAMU is playing a strong institutional role in helping to create a new generation of leaders and informed citizens."

The announcement came shortly after the ribbon cutting and naming ceremony for the amphitheater, a project envisioned and partially funded by students. Their commitment unlocked investments from alumni, including Packer, who graduated magna cum laude from FAMU in 1996. He has gone on to become one of the most prolific and successful film producers in the industry, with a string of No. 1 box-office hits such as "Girls Trip," and he is the founder and CEO of his own production company. Knight's commitment to integrate digital technology and equipment into the amphitheater will fulfill a top priority for FAMU students and administrators. FAMU President Larry Robinson, Ph.D., sees this investment as a significant opportunity to advance the University's tech-forward vision while also driving one of the University's key strategic priorities, which include exceptional student experience, transformational alumni, and community engagement.

"The Amphitheater began as a student idea for a space to explore the possibilities that exist on campus to advance the storied history of entrepreneurship and cultural activity that the "Set" has provided for our students and the Tallahassee community for generations. Thanks to the generosity of the Knight Foundation, our students' vision will be realized. This gift also allows us to give proper tribute to the residence halls that once stood on the sites as a home away from home for female students for decades," Robinson said. "FAMU now has another venue to celebrate the wealth of creative talent and ingenuity of our students."

Knight has long invested in public spaces to make them more accessible and welcoming for all residents. Knight's latest FAMU investment aims to foster an informed and engaged community by using digital technology to attach people to place and to each other.

"As a FAMU alumna, I am inspired by the students' vision to ensure future generations of Rattlers, Tallahassee residents and visitors have a safe public square to connect with each other and plug into current performing and visual arts and news," said Roshell R. Rinkins, Knight's senior director of Grants and Administration. "I am proud of Knight's continued investments in public spaces to amplify civic engagement and attach people to their community."

The 25,000-square-foot Knight Foundation Plaza is located next to FAMU's Student Center and "The Set," a three-block stretch on South Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard that has become a destination for convening students and alumni on campus.

"The new space not only is a new beautiful green space on our campus for students to enjoy, but it also represents the seeds that are sown and products that are created, directly from our institution," said former FAMU SGA President Carrington Whigham. "It inspires us to know that we are very capable to be successful in life, because the amphitheater is dedicated from an amazing alum that walked the same campus we do."

Knight's latest investment follows other commitments the Foundation has made to FAMU, including a grant to establish a Knight Chair in Student Achievement in the journalism program. Knight Chairs are top professionals who bridge the newsroom-classroom divide with innovative teaching, major outreach projects and their own journalism. Since the program began in 1990, Knight has endowed 26 chairs and professors at 23 universities. The chairs have helped lead journalism and media education — and journalism itself — toward a better future in the digital age.




