

Descriptive Summary of 2017 Assessment Roundtable Engagement Survey

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
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Overview of Report

The 2017 Assessment Roundtable was held on March 15th, 2017. An engagement survey designed to gauge participants' perceptions of their experiences was administered following the Round Table.

Reminder correspondence was sent to participants who did not respond to the initial mailing. The survey officially closed on March 31st, 2017. Our attendance record indicated that (N=27) individuals participated in the 2017 Assessment Roundtable. Of this proportion, (n=17) attendees participated in the engagement survey, representing an overall response rate of 63%. Following is a descriptive summary of the findings.

1) What is your current position/status?





2) The presentation materials provided were adequate.





3) The facilities were conducive to learning.





4) The speaker(s) seemed knowledgeable of the topics.












