In addition, the student received a certificate from the class instructor as proof of completion of their mock interview training. We will move toward incorporating technology use by holding online mock interviews in the future.

The intention is to have a dedicated employee to enhance the internship process by fpcusing on the market, assisting students with professional development (i.e., helping with resumes, the application process), and helpign students
