I understand that Optional Practical Training (OPT) is defined in the regulations as "temporary employment for practical training directly related to the student's major area of study". A F-l student applying for Optional Practical Training (OPT) MUST have been **enrolled on a full-time basis** in a service-approved institution for at least one full academic year. A student who still has coursework remaining in his/her degree program can only work 20 hours or less per week while school is in session. OPT after completion of the course of study will only be granted for full-time use and must be applied for prior to the completion of course requirements or prior to completion of the course of study. Use of full time Curriculum Practical Training (CPT) for 12 months or more eliminates the participant's eligibility for Optional Practical Training (OPT).

By my signature below I am attesting that:

The student has been lawfully enrolled full-time for a full academic year;

The OPT proposed is directly related to the student's major area of study;

The work sought for OPT is commensurate with the student's educational level;

The student may submit application for OPT up to 90 days prior to being enrolled for one full academic year,

but the period of employment will not begin until the completion of the full academic year.
