Title: Furthering CAB Initiatives
Legislation: Senate Appropriation Bill

Whereas,	The Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University Student Senate is the Legislative Branch of the Student Government Association and is empowered to pass legislation as it deems necessary to carry out the functions of the Student Government Association.
Whereas,	The Student Government Association Student Senate has the authority to allocate different organizations and agencies funding through the Senate Unallocated Account.
Whereas,	The Campus Activities Board (CAB) is a student-led organization dedicated to fostering campus engagement by planning, promoting, and executing events that serve the cultural, educational, and social interests of the FAMU student body; and campus. CAB aims to enhance student life through large-scale events that contribute to community building, school spirit, and student success.

Whereas,	Due to the lack of funding, CAB has struggled to put on efficient and impactful programming. Without sufficient financial resources, it has been challenging to organize events that fully engage and benefit students. The limitations in funding have restricted the scale, quality, and variety of programs that CAB can offer, ultimately affecting student participation and overall experience. Securing additional funding or finding creative solutions to maximize resources is essential to ensuring that CAB can continue to provide meaningful programming for the student body.
Whereas,	The following Spring 2025 events require financial support to ensure their success and impact: 1. Orange and Green Week (February 21 – March 1, 2025) - o A week-long series of events celebrating FAMU pride and student engagement. - o Budget Request: \$5,000 - o Expenses Include: Food, DJ, facilities, games, supplies, and other event necessities. 2. The COLAC Awards (April 20, 2025) - o The official university ceremony recognizing outstanding student leaders, organizations, faculty, and staff. - o Budget Request: \$12,000 - o Expenses Include: Venue reservation, security, awards, DJ, and other production costs. 3. Cram Jam (April 27, 2025) - o A late-night study session and social event designed to help students de-stress and prepare for final exams. - o Budget Request: \$10,000

	o Expenses Include: Food, games, decorations, DJ, and other student engagement activities.
Therefore,	Be it appropriated, the Student Senate allocates twenty seven thousand (\$27,000) to Campus Activity Board (CAB), from the the Senate Unallocated Account, to fund new initiatives. Also, be it enacted, that CAB will provide a post-event financial report to SGA detailing the use of allocated funds and the impact of each event on student engagement.

Legislation: Senate Appropriation Bill

Whereas,	The Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University Student Senate is the Legislative Branch of the Student Government Association and is empowered to pass legislation as it deems necessary to carry out the functions of the Student Government Association.
Whereas,	The Student Bar Association is the governing body for all students and organizations at the FAMU College of Law located miles away in Orlando, FL. As the governing organization it is our responsibility to cover major law school events such as Barrister's Ball, Graduation Reception, and funding for student organizations.
Whereas,	SBA's effectiveness in fulfilling its objectives is hampered by inadequate funding. Insufficient financial resources limit the organization's capacity to provide essential services such as funding to student organizations, school wide initiatives, and transition events. Also, the lack of funding restricts SBA's ability to engage effectively with the student

	body and support all student organizations at the law school.
Therefore,	Be it appropriated, that a special allocation request of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) A & S funding in the amount of be granted to the Student Bar Association for the purpose of the end of the semester Barristers Ball, Grad week, Hooding Reception, and SBA/student organization transition ceremony.
