Legislation: Senate Appropriation Bill

Whereas,	The Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University Student Senate is the Legislative Branch of the Student Government Association and is empowered to pass legislation as it deems necessary to carry out the functions of the Student Government Association.
Whereas,	The Student Government Association Student Senate has the authority to allocate different organizations and agencies funding through the Senate Unallocated Account.
Whereas,	The Student Government Association (SGA) at Florida A&M University (FAMU) proudly welcomes new students by funding their class shirts, fostering a strong sense of unity and school pride from day one. This is done during orientations.
Whereas,	This initiative ensures that every incoming student feels included and connected to their peers, creating a shared identity as they begin their journey at FAMU. Wearing the class shirt not only symbolizes school spirit but also serves as a reminder that each student is part of a historic

	legacy of excellence, leadership, and community at FAMU.
Whereas,	By the Student Senate allocating money to keep the strong tradition of SGA providing incoming classes shirts, the incoming students can still have a sense of unity.
Therefore,	Be it appropriated, the Student Senate allocates nineteen thousand five hundred dollars (\$19,500) to the New Student Orientation Office, from the Senate Unallocated Account.
