Title: Golf Carts Funding
Legislation: Senate Appropriation Bill

Whereas,	The Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University Student Senate is the Legislative Branch of the Student Government Association and is empowered to pass legislation as it deems necessary to carry out the functions of the Student Government Association.
Whereas,	The Student Government Association Student Senate has the authority to allocate different organizations and agencies funding through the Senate Unallocated Account.
Whereas,	The Student Government Association (SGA) is in urgent need of new golf carts as the current fleet is no longer operational. The absence of functional golf carts poses significant challenges in effectively managing events such as Be Out Day, Homecoming, the SGA Crab Boil, and other key activities. Additionally, the lack of transportation options for guests visiting the campus reflects poorly on both the university and SGA, detracting from the level of professionalism and hospitality we strive to uphold. Investing in new golf carts will not only ensure the seamless execution of events

	but also enhance the overall experience for guests and reinforce the university's reputation.
Whereas,	By allocating twenty-seven thousand dollars to Joint Operations for the purchase of new golf carts, the Senate will empower student leaders to enhance campus life and provide a reliable mode of transportation. This investment will support the smooth execution of campus events and improve the overall experience for students and guests.
Therefore,	Be it appropriated, the Student Senate allocates thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) to Joint Operations, from the carry forward dollars, to fund new golf carts.

Proviso Language: This piece of legislation will take effect in immediately upon signage by the Senate President and Student Government Association President.
