Legislation: Resolution Bill

Whereas,	The Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University Student Senate is the Legislative Branch of the Student Government Association and is empowered to pass legislation as it deems necessary to carry out the functions of the Student Government Association.
Whereas,	The importance of preserving green spaces for environmental health and biodiversity has been well-documented, with the removal of these spaces contributing to ecological degradation and loss of native species;
Whereas,	Scientific studies show that replacing lost green space with sustainable native plants is a crucial step in maintaining ecosystem balance and providing natural habitats for local wildlife;
Therefore,	Be it resolved, that any green space torn down must be replaced with sustainable native plants that encourage ecological restoration and support local wildlife, ensuring a healthy, biodiverse environment for future generations.
