**Title: Minority Association of Premedical Students
Legislation: Senate Allocation Bill (SAB)**

Whereas,	The Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University Student Senate is the Legislative Branch of the Student Government Association and is empowered to pass legislation as it deems necessary to carry out the functions of the Student Government Association.
Whereas,	The Minority Association of Premedical Students (MAPS) helps pre-med students professionally and academically to prepare for any health care related fields. Being that only 3% of the medical field consists of minorities, this organization is a steppingstone that provides mentorships, shadowing opportunities and guidance through their undergraduate career.

Whereas,	The Annual Medical Education Conference (AMEC) is a yearly conference for pre-med students, current medical students and practicing physicians. It provides the opportunity for minority students to receive internships, networking, and medical school recruitment. AMEC is used to provide students with opportunities that aren't normally offered as FAMU students. The conference focuses on professional development, networking, and advancing diversity in medicine. It includes workshops, keynote speakers, medical school recruitment fairs, and opportunities for FAMU students to connect to peers and mentors within their fields.
Therefore,	Be it appropriated, fourteen thousand eight hundred and fifty five dollars (\$14,855.00) to ensure the ability for MAPS to attend the Annual Medical Education Conference from April 16-20 th in St. Louis, Missouri.
