Title: SR25SP-009 Clean and Green Campus
Legislation: Resolution Bill

Whereas,	The Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University Student Senate is the Legislative Branch of the Student Government Association and is empowered to pass legislation as it deems necessary to carry out the functions of the Student Government Association.
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Whereas,	The current number of waste and recycling bins available on the campus of Florida A&M University (FAMU) is insufficient to meet the needs of the student body, faculty, and staff, leading to overflowing bins and increased litter.
Whereas,	The lack of regular trash pickups negatively impacts the aesthetic appearance of the campus, creates an unsanitary environment, and contributes to an unhealthy living and learning atmosphere for students, staff, and visitors.
Therefore,	Be it resolved that the Florida A&M University administration will allocate additional resources to increase the number of waste bins and recycling bins placed in high-traffic areas on campus and implement a plan to increase the frequency of trash pickups, ensuring that the campus is kept clean and environmentally responsible for the benefit of the entire FAMU community.

Proviso Language: This piece of legislation will take effect in immediately upon signage by the Senate President and Student Government Association President.
