Title: Sustainability Homecoming & Big Events
Legislation: Resolution Bill

Whereas,	The Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University Student Senate is the Legislative Branch of the Student Government Association and is empowered to pass legislation as it deems necessary to carry out the functions of the Student Government Association.
Whereas,	large-scale student activities and events, such as Homecoming, often generate significant amounts of waste that negatively impact the environment, local communities, and the campus;
Whereas,	vendors, tailgaters, and event organizers often fail to take responsibility for the waste they generate, leading to environmental harm and additional cleanup efforts;
Therefore,	Be it resolved, the 54 th Student Senate urges Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University to implement a waste management policy that incorporates a cleaning fee for leaving waste in their designated areas.
